

Parable of the Sower

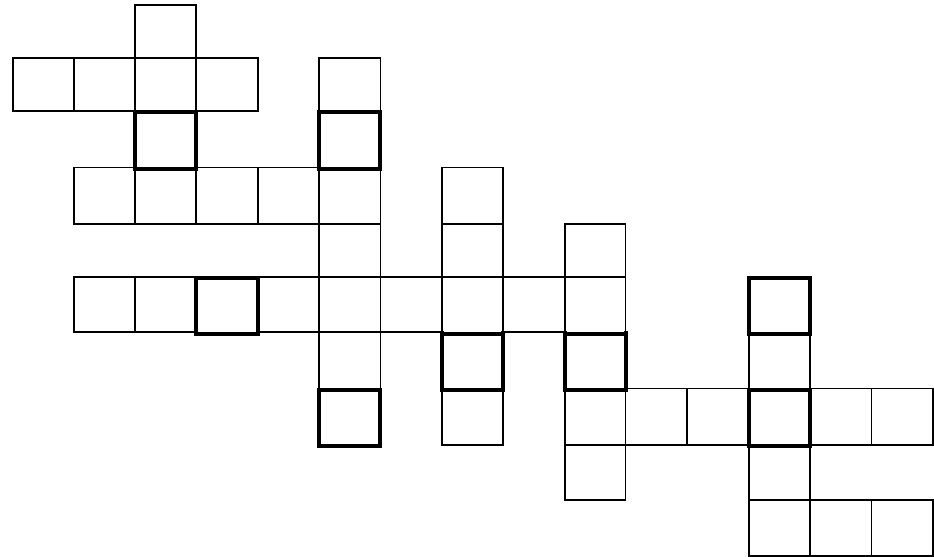
